

How to prepare your site for an inflatable



- *Find a location no more than 50 feet away from an electrical source (115 volt electrical outlet – stronger outlets are in the kitchens and laundry room). While the outlet will be used by an Inflatable, we ask that nothing else be plugged in. If you are renting more than one Inflatable, you will have to use outlets from different circuits.**
- *If no outlet is available, we do offer gas generators for rent (subject to availability).**
- *Your setup location should be at least 4 feet larger than the size of the Inflatable to allow for movement and clearance.**
- *Select a dry leveled area; preferably on a grassy surface. Depending on the type of event, we can also set-up on other surfaces.**
- *You must advise us in advance if you plan to have an Inflatable set up on concrete or asphalt. We will need to lay tarps down to protect the base of the Inflatable.**
- *If you are planning to set up at a park then you must contact that park in advance. You must let them know that you are having an Inflatable there and arrange to have a permit pass to have an Inflatable set up. This could take several days to process. Also, check to see if they offer a standard 115-volt outlet to plug in your Inflatable.**
- *Provide an area away from electrical cords, water, and/or any other harmful objects; such as, branches, fences, fire, walls, rocks, pipes or sprinklers.**
- *If there is no one around to provide us access to your location, we will not be responsible for late setup. Your original time frame reserved will be invoiced, as there will not be a deduction on your reserved time allotment.**
